LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS is a community awareness program of the Greensboro Chamber of Commerce designed to develop informed, motivated and committed retired and semi-retired persons for the Greater Greensboro Area.

What are the objectives of LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS?

The principle objectives of LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS are to:

- Broaden retired and semi-retired citizen's knowledge of the community through presentations, discussions and visits in a series of six half-day sessions
- Discover creative new ways to use each member's energies and talents in community leadership
- Learn about volunteer self-enrichment programs and opportunities
- Meet new friends who share the same intellectual curiosity and commitment to our community

How does LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS accomplish these objectives?

LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS participants are given new insight into the community through a series of six half-day sessions held at various locations in the community:

- Orientation/History of Greensboro
- Government/Public Safety
- Economic Development
- Education
- Understanding Differences
- Quality of Life
- Understanding Difference
- Optional: Two Days of Tours around the City

Community resources intimately familiar with community issues and problems will meet with participants in a seminar setting and discuss critical issues, creative possibilities, potential solutions and future plans.

Who should apply for participation in LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS?

Individuals who are:

- Retired or semi-retired (long-time Greensboro/Guilford County residents and **especially** recently retired citizens relocating to the area as newcomers)
- Interested in learning more about Greensboro's past, present, and future

What are the time commitments and attendance requirements for LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS?

There are six sessions. The first will be held on Wednesday. The remaining will be on Tuesdays, beginning at 8:30 a.m. and ending at 3:00 p.m. The times for the two additional tour days may be slightly different. A continental breakfast is available at 8:15 a.m. Each session includes presentations, discussions and lunch. Each session will be held at a different location each week to help participants learn more about the city. Attendance is recommended at all sessions, although not required.

What does it cost to attend LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS?

LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS fee is \$150 per individual. The fee covers all expenses such as meals, bus tour transportation, class materials, supplies, etc. Touring days will/may have additional minimal charges.

Will I be required to sign up for volunteer assignments upon completion of LEADERSHIP GREENSBORO SENIORS program?

No. Although many of the organizations that make presentations have volunteer opportunities available, participants are not required to sign-up for volunteer assignments.
